CASI PROCEDURES

•Make sure that the office where the CASI will be held affords privacy.

•The following equipment will be needed to conduct the CASI:

A computer

Working internet connection

 Let participant know staff will be readily available if they have any questions/concerns



<u>Procedures</u>








CASI Question Types


