# 1. <u>Updated Pelvic Exam Diagrams CRF (non-DataFax)</u>

The non-DataFax Pelvic Diagrams form has been updated to version 2.0 (dated 22-APR-16). Specifically, the check box label at the top of the form has been corrected from "abnormal findings observed" to "no normal variants or abnormal findings observed". The updated version 2.0 label is consistent with the form instructions on the back of the form, which state, "If there are no variants of normal or abnormal findings observed mark the "no normal variants or abnormal findings observed" box.

Version 2.0 of the Pelvic Exam Diagrams form can be implemented immediately, and should be used going forward when completion of this form is required. Please discontinue further use of version 1.0 of the form.
