Introduction

- The two kits from Trinity Biotech have different lot#
 - Unigold Recombigen (US Market/FDA Approved) 1206506
 - Unigold (African Market) 1206502

Problem Background

- Missed key detailed in the protocol and NL communications
 - SMILE
 - IMPAACT
 - MTN
 - ACTG
- Misinformation by suppliers

Implications

- Protocol deviation
 - Study stopped/delayed
 - Completion of PD/note to file for each participant

 Lengthy processes of validation and approval of the new kit version

Corrective Action

 Reviewed communication from Networks, HPTN and SMILE in regards to Rapid HIV Reporting and FDA kit approval.

 The lab worked closely with NL to identify reliable source for the FDA approval Unigold Recombigen kits

Corrective Action

SOP written and approved

Validation completed for Unigold Recombigen

All MTN-020 samples were re-analyzed

NL Support

 Lab still receives support from NL in relation to kit supplies that are not available locally

 Established a relationship with BARC for study supplies of kits

Steps Instituted to Prevent Future Occurrence

- Detailed review of protocol kit requirements
- Submission of equipment/reagent reference/product# to the NL for FDA approval verification
- Identification of reputable/reliable supplier for different kits as per NL requirements

Lessons Learned

- Small details
 - Big implications

 Make thorough review of all study and Network documents
