Material:

- Cryobox with samples (mini M & M candies represent 'plasma')
- Mini-shipping box (imagine that this is a world Courier Box with foam lining)
- Fake dry ice
- Sharpie
- Manifest
- Box Map
- Rubber bands
- Plastic bag
- Absorbent material (can be a paper towel)
- Stickers
- World Courier Waybill

You just received a box of samples out of the freezer from the lab that will now need sent to CPAL (Clinical Pharmacology Analytical Lab) as soon as possible.
