Oral Abstract Sessions

- Sessions will be thematically driven
- Each session will have six oral abstracts or a "state-of-the-art" overview plus four abstracts.
- Total of 15 oral sessions
- Approximately 90 oral abstracts



Posters and Poster Discussion Sessions

- Three dedicated poster viewing sessions
- Posters will change each day and will be clustered in thematic groups
- Six poster discussion sessions
 - 4-5 posters will be selected by Scientific Program Committee
 - Each poster presenter will summarize data in 2-3 slides in 5 minutes

 - February 1st 2010










Abstract Review Process



Abstract Review Process

- Abstracts will be submitted via the conference website
- All abstracts will be reviewed by interdisciplinary subgroups of the M2010 Scientific Program Committee
- Abstracts will not be blinded
- Scoring will be based on 1-5 scale
 - 1: Oral presentation
 - 5: Rejection

Scholarships

- Sponsorship from NIH OAR and anticipated support from Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation will fund approximately 400 scholarships and travel grants
- Goal is to sponsor individuals <u>actively</u> involved in all aspects of HIV prevention research including microbicide development





Scholarship Review Process

- Submission through conference website
- Abstract submission encouraged but <u>not</u> mandated
- Scientific scholarships will be linked to quality of abstracts
- Other categories will be evaluated by scholarship committee

 - Attendance at journalist training program


