

MTN-041: Explanation of a Storyboard

What is a storyboard?

A storyboard is a set of sequential illustrations that is a motionless representation of what will be shown in a motion picture or animated video. It typically includes the voiceover or subtitle text for each frame of the video.

A storyboard in MTN-041.

The storyboard for the MTN-041 video shows each key frame of the video with the text of what will be spoken (English) and displayed as subtitles (local language). The full video will be an animated version of this storyboard (i.e. characters moving or scenes transitioning).
