

Strategies / Technologies to Avoid co-enrollment

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Study Preparedness Activities

- Define target population for research question
- Each clinical trial should aim to have a well defined unique geographic recruitment area where endpoints are expected to accumulate
- For VOICE, this info will be derived from 035 data or preparedness work for new sites

Strategies in Place

At screening / enrollment potential participant is identified by her UNIQUE National ID (SA and Zim) that is entered into common Excel database across CRS studies within common data base.

The common data base allows unique ID number to flag out if potential participant is enrolled in any of the CRS's

Common Data Base

- Two different Menus: search by name or search by Unique National ID number has Name, DOB and picture in Zim) as built in QC step

Newer Technologies

- Planned use of Finger Print Reader
Software linked to common data base
- Use of scanner that reads ID numbers to
avoid mistyping digits
