	Product development should focus on systemic PrEP (implants, long-acting injectables or oral PrEP) either alone or as a MPT because this approach is far more efficacious than any topical strategy VS. Topically delivered (rings or other formulations) products are needed to protect women from HIV and pregnancy (MPT) because they are safe, limit likelihood of selecting for resistant viruses and provide local high drug levels that prevent HIV at the portal of entry.
